

Material

Biodegradable plastic mixed with either coffee shell or wood waste (Biodegradable Sand and Earth Grey is made with coffee shell waste. Biodegradable Light Green and Terracotta is made with wood waste.)

Inner frame: 94% recycled stainless steel

Made of biodegradable materials

Innovative technology allows us to make furniture of waste materials by combining a waste fibre with a biodegradable binder material. The mix of materials results in a unique compound suitable for press moulding.

The Alder Stool is made in a Matek[™] blend of biodegradable plastic mixed with either coffee shell or wood waste.

Take-back system

Our unique Matek[™] material blends allow Mater to offer a circular take-back system. The take-back system is an essential step towards Mater's vision of becoming one hundred percent circular.

Maintenance guide

Please note that the stool is handcrafted and made from natural fibers, and biodegradable plastic - minor blemishes and imperfections may be visible. These are not considered defects and do not interfere with the quality and function of the product.

Always remove stains quickly before they can do any permanent damage to the furniture. When you move your furniture make sure you lift it rather than pulling or pushing it to avoid damaging the floor, base and mountings.

Avoid improper use such as tilting, putting your feet on the furniture or standing on it. Be careful not to damage or scratch the surface with sharp objects.

Matek™

The Matek[™] material is made from a mix of recycled fibre and plastic waste. It offers a strong, durable surface that is easy to clean and requires very little maintenance.

For daily care, it is recommended to dust the surface with a soft cloth. The surface can be cleaned with a soft cloth wrung out in a mild solution of lukewarm water and a universal cleaning detergent. Avoid using abrasive cleaning agents and harsh detergents, as these may damage the surface.

Avoid placing Matek[™] furniture in direct sunlight, excessive heat, or humidity over longer periods of time, as this can affect the appearance of the material. For tabletops, we always recommend using trivets under hot objects, such as coffee pots and cups, to prevent damage to the surface.

As MatekTM furniture is made from a blend of natural materials, each piece is unique, and its appearance may vary from item to item. A slight change in colour over the years is also to be expected.

Matek[™] furniture also has a distinct smell when first unpacked, but this will fade after a few days of use.
